U.S. Foreign Policy Colloquium 2020 What Should You Bring?

To wear:

- Tuesday: Casual clothes – the only time jeans, shorts, and t-shirts are allowed
- Wednesday: Business casual
 - Bring comfortable shoes for the site visits as you will be walking or taking the metro
- Thursday: Business casual during the day, **business formal for the keynote reception**
- Friday: Business casual

What clothes to pack?

- One business formal outfit
 - Skirts/pants, blouses or dresses for women
 - Suit (collared shirt, tie, and blazer) for men
- Two-three business casual outfits
 - Skirts/pants with nice tops or dresses for women
 - Collared shirts and nice pants for men
- One heavy weight sweater or jacket for the GW classroom*
- One pair of comfortable walking shoes (if they are not business casual appropriate, you can always change into your business shoes outside the site visit)
- One pair of dress shoes
 - Flats, wedges, heels, oxfords, etc. for women
 - Oxfords, loafers, etc. for men
 - No sneakers or flip flops
- Whatever you want to wear in your free time!

What else to pack?

- **Passport – many site visits require passports for entry**
- Business cards to exchange with other participants and reception guests
- Notebook
- Umbrella
 - Be sure to check the weather forecast prior to arriving in Washington, D.C.

** Keep in mind that while it may be hot and humid outside, the Elliott School may be heavily air-conditioned. A sweater or jacket is recommended.*
