Born in 1942, President Hu studied hydraulic engineering at Beijing's prestigious Tsinghua University, preparing him for the challenges of today's high-tech world. After graduation, he served in various government technical departments and was actively involved in building hydro-power plants and in infrastructural development; he also served in many local and central governmental positions, thereby gaining rich management and leadership experience over the years. He served in many leadership roles in China's Communist Youth League (CYLC), playing an important role in producing a generation of young leaders.

Hu Jintao successively served as the first secretary of the CYLC, party secretary of Guizhou Province and Tibet Autonomous Region, member of the Standing Committee of the Politburo of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China, and vice president of the People's Republic of China. He was elected general secretary of the CPC Central Committee in November 2002, president of the People's Republic of China in March 2003 and chairman of the Central Military Commission in September 2004.

President Hu is married to Madame Liu Yongqing; they have two children, a son and a daughter.
